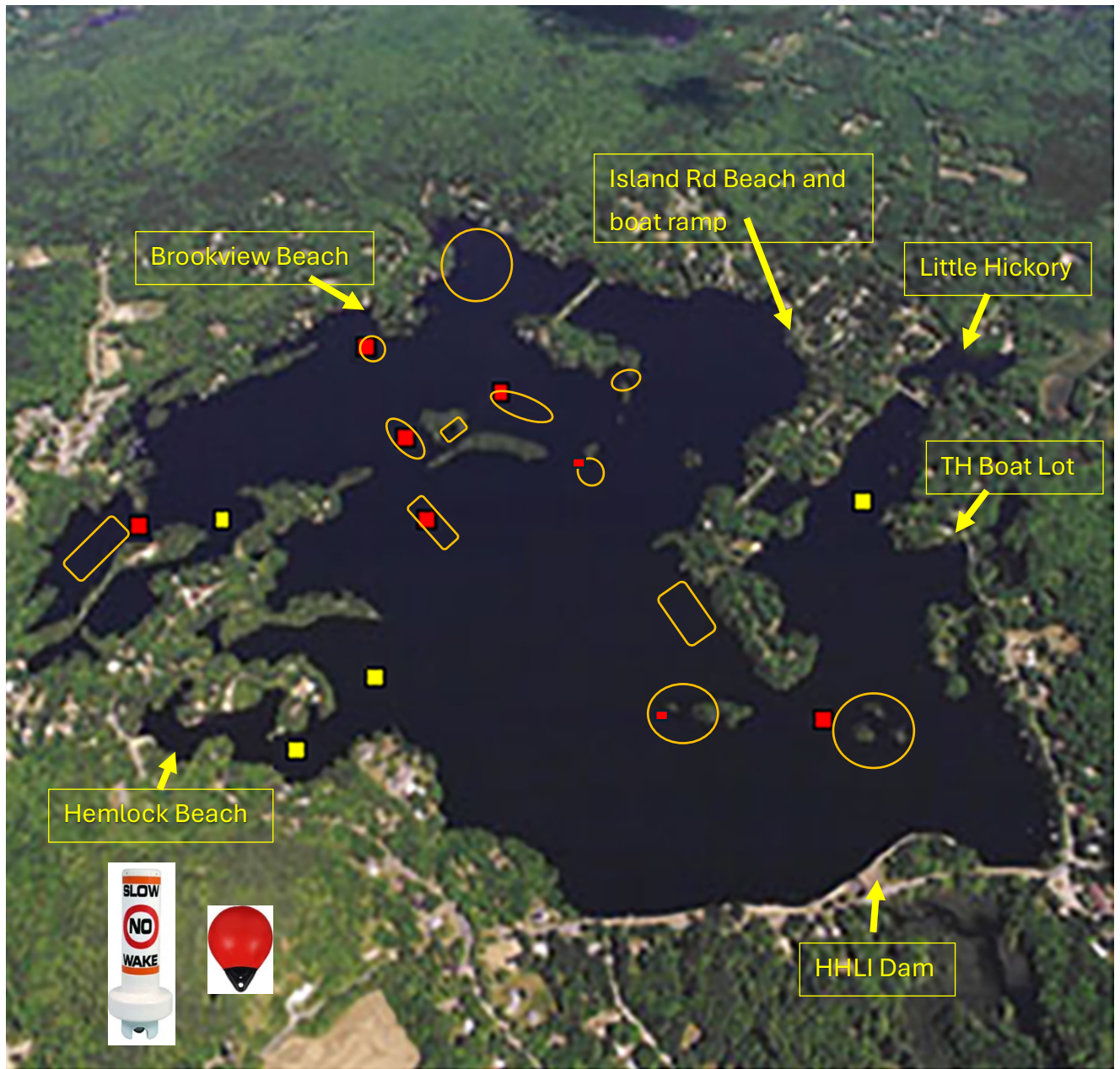


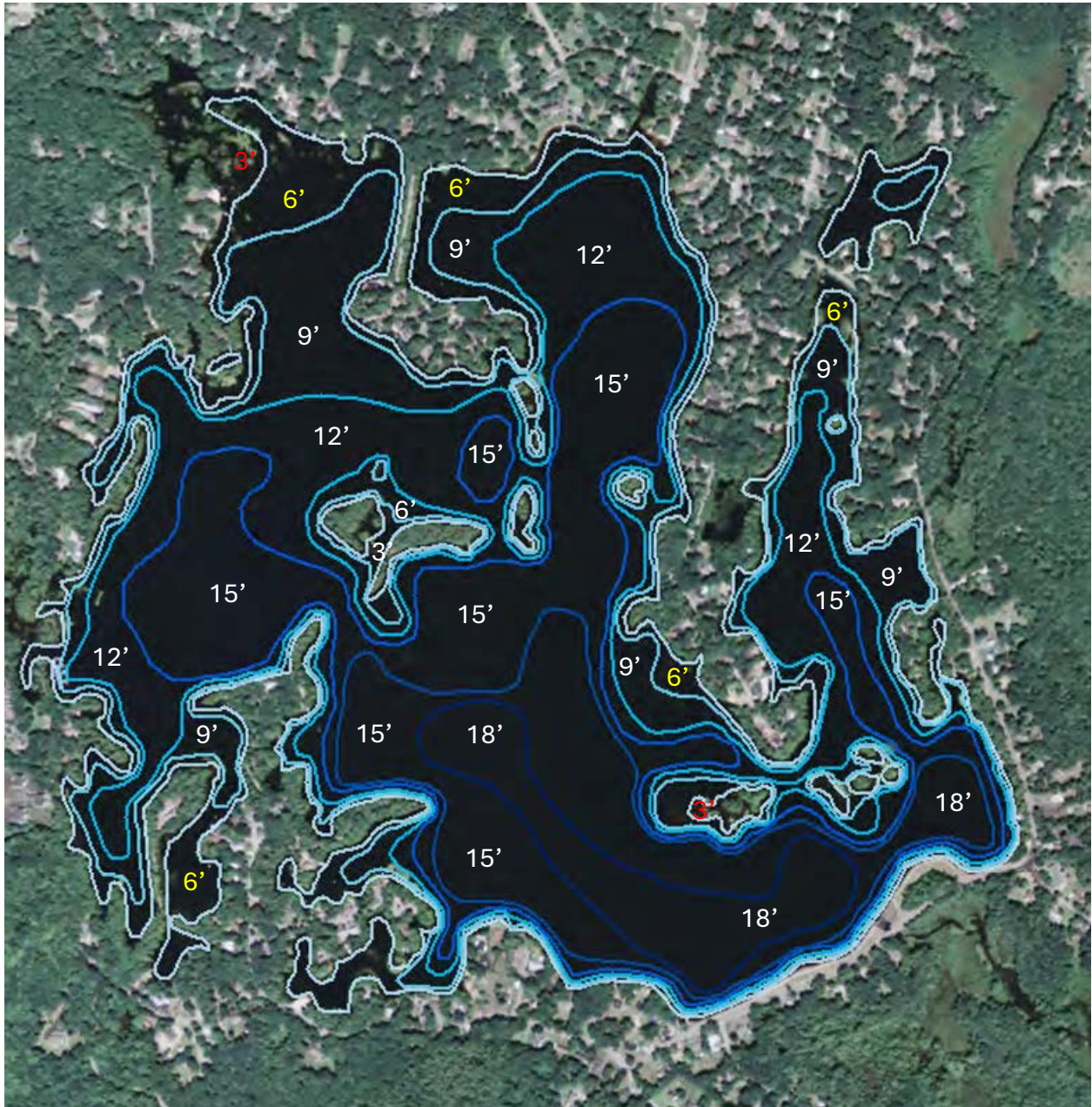
Hickory Hills Lake Buoy Locations



Yellow Marks– No Wake Buoys Red Marks – Hazard Buoys Orange outline – Shallow area

No-Wake Buoys indicate where boats near shore or in coves should be travelling at slow speeds to avoid generating wake waves which encourage shoreline erosion.

Red hazard buoys indicate that a shallow hidden hazard is in the area. Generally traveling near the shore, especially near islands, one is likely to encounter shallow hazards which will damage engines and/or propellers. Not all shallow areas are marked with buoys. Buoys are deployed around Memorial Day and Removed after Labor Day.
