



LANDFILL OPEN FOR YARD DEBRIS

Lunenburg's Landfill off Young's Road will be open this season on consecutive Saturdays from April 20th to June 1st 8am - 4pm (travel permitted only on TOWN EASEMENT. No trespassing on Tri-Town Landing Development). The accepted materials are grass clippings, bark mulch, wood chips, leaves, brush-diameter not to exceed three inches and some shrubbery & plantings, all containers must be removed.

No household trash, garbage or rubbish of any kind can remain at the landfill.

Fanwort Update—Volunteers Needed to Survey!

The fight against Fanwort will continue in earnest this year. Fanwort is a competitive plant that is capable of rapid growth and spread. This invasive weed has the potential to devastate the lake if not controlled. Fanwort originated in the boat ramp cove and tremendous effort was expended to contain it. Although our containment efforts were mostly successful, we have found sporadic growth in numerous areas of the lake.

One of the most crucial components of the fanwort effort is to survey the lake and identify any spread so that we can take the necessary steps to mitigate it. The lake has been cut into zones and volunteers within each zone are requested to swim and/or boat and report any suspicious plants they discover. Ideally we would like to have a Zone Captain and 3 assistants, for each area so that each person can be responsible for surveying one week a month. Areas of infestation that have been identified have been successfully eradicated by our suction harvester! It is crucial that we find the plant so that it can be removed immediately, Fanwort can grow more than I" per day. Many thanks to all of the volunteers who assisted in this effort last year! We really need more volunteers this year! Even if you can only do one or two surveys it will be a huge help! If you are not able to volunteer on a regular basis, becoming familiar with the plant and keeping an eye out for it, any time you are on the lake would be helpful. Won't you please let us know if you would be interested in and willing to help us out with either our survey or plant removal efforts, which are for the mutual benefit of all of us who use the Lake?

This month, the pipeline and earthen dam constructed within the boat ramp cove have been removed. The majority of Fanwort has been eradicated from this area by installing benthic barriers (which were removed last year) and scraping the cove bottom. Should any plants be found in this area they will be removed by the suction harvester.

While you are enjoying the lake this summer, please make a special effort to look for this plant. It's bright green color is quite obvious in comparison to native plants and its fan-like leaves are distinctive. If you see Fanwort FLOATING on the top of the water, please pick it up. If you see it growing, immediately leave the area; and contact Paula Bertram at

PLANT - Fanwort is extremely fragile and spreads by fragmentation. A trained crew will be deployed to remove the plants.

The Nominating Committee is accepting names of people interested in serving on the Board of Directors during 2013-2014. Any





Please make any changes on the form provided.

To obtain a car sticker which enables you to park in the resident only beach lots, please send a copy of your current vehicle registration. The stickers are free to residents in good standing. This is one of the few ways we have to insure only residents are using our lake facilities. Even if you had a car sticker before we cannot issue stickers without first seeing a copy of your current vehicle registration.

Landlords please ensure the office has current names and phone numbers for your tenants; please register any boats they may have; provide them with IDs; and give tenants a copy of the annual license you receive from the office. We appreciate all your help in keeping our records up to date.
