





Dam Renovation Update

The Dam committee has been very busy this past year and we've been asked to provide an update. For those of you at the Annual meeting you'll remember we applied for a low interest loan from the state's newly formed dam repair fund.

Although our application was well crafted and our needs articulated, we were informed that we did not make the cut. Reviewing those that did, revealed that they were in much more dire straits than we are.

This past year during our bi-annual safety inspection a couple key items were identified. Seepage from the earthen embankment is showing signs of possible internal erosion and maintenance is needed to our emergency sluice gate. To address these concerns we have contracted the engineering firm Tighe & Bond to create design plans for an improved drainage swale at the tow of the earthen embankment off Townsend Harbor Rd just east of the concrete dam. We are also looking into options on maintaining the emergency sluice gate.

In preparations for these projects we contacted the office of Dam Safety regarding our ongoing concern that our spillway does not meet the state's updated requirements. In our conversation we were informed that "improvement projects" such as the drainage swale and emergency low level access gate (sluice gate) would be permitted by the state without triggering the immediate need to begin a "performance" project like the inevitable increasing of our spillway.

As we continue to save and plan for the spillway redesign you will see further improvements to our Dam and the infrastructure that supports it. ~ Dam Committee




2014 Annual Bills

The 2014 HHL annual maintenance fees statements were mailed on April 1st and are due by May 1st. Included, is the 2014 Boat Launch Schedule (also found on our website).

Please take a few minutes to read the letter enclosed; it answers some of the more frequently asked questions. Don't forget to update your email addresses and phone numbers. We only send one or two emails a month during the summer, and we keep all contact information private. We also ask you check to make sure we have the correct details on your boats and to make any changes on the form provided.

To obtain a **FREE** car sticker which enables you to park in the resident only beach lots, please send a copy of your current vehicle registration. This is one of the few ways we have to insure only residents are using our lake facilities. Even if you had a car sticker before, we cannot issue stickers without first seeing a copy of your current vehicle registration.

Landlords please ensure the office has current names & phone numbers for your tenants and register any boats they have; provide them with IDs; and give a copy of the license you receive from the office. We appreciate your help & cooperation in keeping our records up to date.

Fanwort Update—Volunteers Needed to Survey!

For those residents who may be new to Fanwort, it is a aggressive invasive weed and competitive plant that is capable of rapid growth and spread and has the potential to devastate the lake if not controlled. It originated in the boat ramp cove and a tremendous effort was expended to contain it. Although our containment efforts were mostly successful, we have found sporadic growth in numerous areas of the lake over the last 2 years.

One of the most crucial components of the fanwort effort is to find it! We do this through volunteers who survey the lake and identify any locations it's growing in so we can take the necessary steps to remove it.

To make this task manageable, the lake has been cut into zones, and volunteers within each zone are requested to swim and/or boat and report any suspicious plants they discover. Ideally we would like to have a Zone Captain and 3 assistants for each Zone so that each person can be responsible for surveying only one day per month.

It is crucial that we find the plant so that it can be removed immediately by our Suction Harvester to prevent further spread, Fanwort can grow more than 1" per day.

Many thanks to all of the volunteers who assisted in this effort last year! We really need more volunteers this year! Even if you can only do one or two surveys it will be a huge help! If you're able to help, please contact Paula Bertram, Betty MacDonald or Fred Malcomb (contact info below). – THANK YOU!

If you are not able to volunteer on a regular basis, becoming familiar with the plant, keeping an eye out for it each time you're on the lake and surveying your own beachfront regularly is critical to our success.

While you are enjoying the lake this summer, please make a special effort to look for this plant. It's bright green color is quite obvious in comparison to native plants and its fan-like leaves are distinctive. If you see Fanwort FLOATING on the top of the water, please pick it up. PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH THE PLANT

- Fanwort is extremely fragile and spreads by fragmentation. A trained crew will be deployed to remove the plants.


Areas of suspected Fanwort are being marked. If you see one of these markers (noodle piece pictured below) in the lake, immediately leave the area and **DO NOT**

REMOVE THE MARKER!!

Fanwort reproduces by fragmentation. Swimming or boating in an area with Fanwort could easily cause the plant to fragment & spread.
